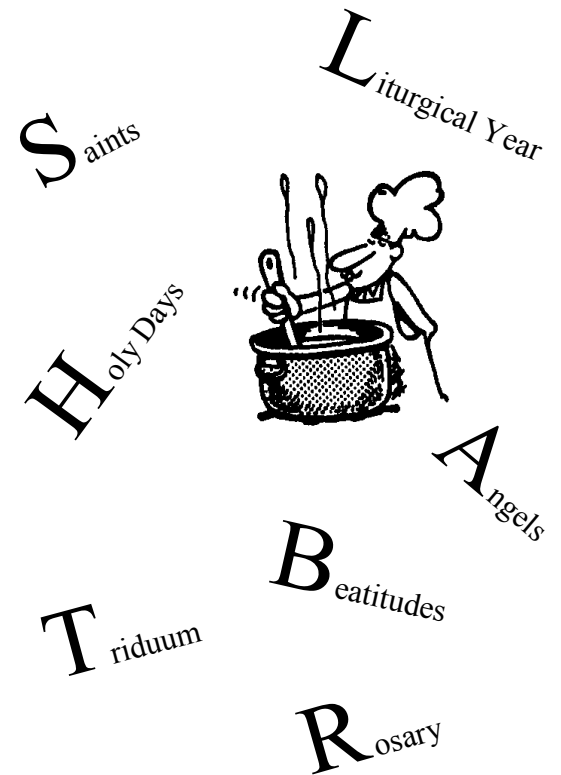

## What is Generations of Faith?

Generations of Faith is an inter-generational approach to faith formation. All members of the parish, from the preschoolers to the seniors, are invited to come together at one event to pray, reflect, share, learn, and enjoy each other's company.

This is how it happens:

- All gather in the Parish Hall after the 4:00 p.m. Mass on the designated Saturday. (Approximately 5:15 p.m.)
- We share a light meal provided by the Parish.
- There is an opening, ice-breaker activity related to the topic of the evening.
- We break into age-level groups for input and discussion.
- All gather again in the Hall for closing thoughts and prayer.
