PARENT PARTICIPATION PROGRAM

The objectives of the Parent Participation Program (PPP) are to involve parents and guardians of all students K-8 and to support and enrich the schools' educational and extra-curricular activities. Each family in K-8 is required to work 25 hours per year. As an option, a family may choose to fulfill all or part of its requirement by paying \$20.00 per hour.

The PTO is responsible for the development and implementation of ancillary programs that enhance the welfare, education, and development of Sacred Heart School students in home, school, church and community. Accordingly, the PTO efforts are designed to support the school's mission statement and philosophy.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

An essential criterion for admission is the informed acceptance by the student and parents of the fact that the school is Catholic in philosophy and practice. All students must participate in the religious education courses offered for their grade level, participate in the worshipping community while in school, and agree to act in a manner consistent with Christian values. Parents/guardians are expected to cooperate with all administrative and educational policies of the school. Parents/guardians who do not fully cooperate and/or who are disruptive in their actions to such may be asked to withdraw their children from school.

Sacred Heart School respects the dignity of all students. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, nationality, ethnic origin or sex, as required by the terms of Title IX of the Education Act of 1972, Public Law 92-318 (as amended by Public Law 93-568).

Admission priority will be as follows:

- ◆ Currently enrolled students who have met the previous years' financial obligations;
- ◆ Siblings of currently enrolled students dependent on available classroom space;
- ◆ Children of registered, contributing and participating members of Sacred Heart Parish;
- ◆ Children of families registered in another Catholic parish that does not have a school for a specific age.
- ◆ Non-Catholics who qualify and agree to conform to the school's religious instruction and policies.
